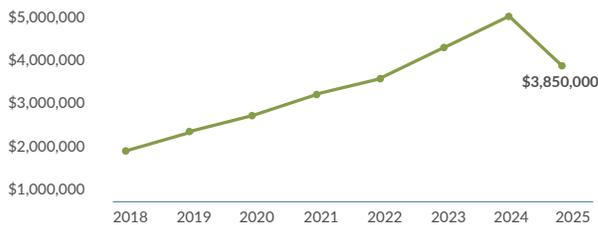
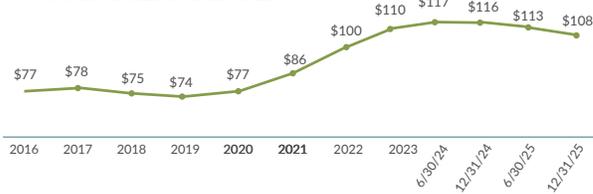

OUR IMPACT

When farmers thrive, land becomes more resilient. When land is resilient, long-term value and impact grow—for investors, communities, and the future of agriculture. We track key impact areas with our farmers:



PESTICIDES & HERBICIDES
Eliminated 29 million lbs of synthetic chemicals from our food system since 2014.



SOIL EROSION
Avoided 95,000 tons of topsoil erosion since 2014.



FARMER ECONOMICS
Helped organic farmers earn \$30 more per acre for their crops.

WHAT WE DO

As a certified B Corp, Iroquois Valley offers investors unique access to an organic farmland REIT designed to deliver stable, risk-adjusted returns. We invest in organic farmland and partner with experienced farmers across the United States through long-term financing structures that support both farm performance and asset resilience.

Our \$124.4 million portfolio includes more than 36,150 acres of diversified farmland across 19 states. Working with a network of over 65 farmers, we strengthen soil health and farm economics while generating consistent, non-concessionary returns for investors.

OUR INVESTMENT OFFERINGS

We offer two investment options designed to deliver attractive risk-adjusted returns while advancing a more resilient food system.

REIT Equity Shares provide investors with ownership in a diversified portfolio of organic farmland. Since inception, the portfolio has delivered an 8% annualized return, driven primarily by land value appreciation. Depending on farmer performance, shares may also earn dividends—aligning investor success with our farmers' long-term productivity.

Rooted in Regeneration (RNR) Notes are fixed-rate promissory notes designed to expand access to capital socially disadvantaged farmers while delivering measurable impact. With our RNR Note offering, we aim to recognize that BIPOC farmers have historically faced significant barriers to accessing financing, even as they overwhelmingly use organic practices. These five-year notes return a portion of earned interest to investors while directing 1.0–1.5% into the RNR Pool. The pool is used to reduce interest rates on mortgages for eligible farmers. Investors earn 0.5–1.5% annually, with the remainder driving expanded access and long-term resilience for BIPOC farming communities.

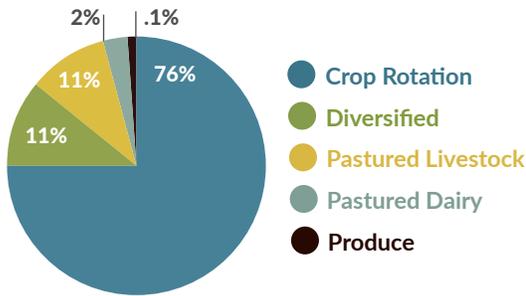

As of 2025 crop year.

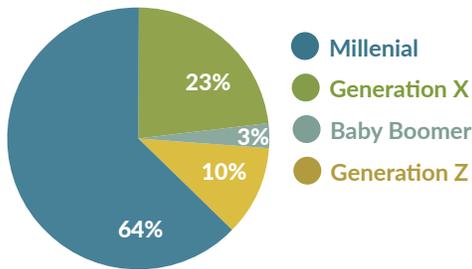

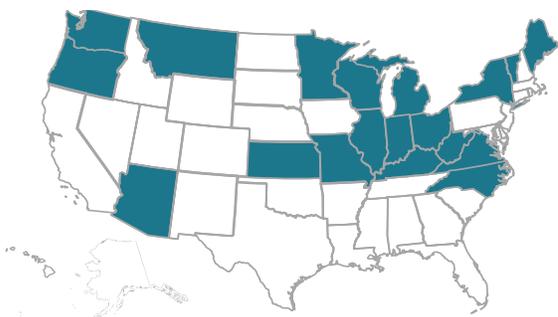

INVESTOR BASE

Iroquois Valley is backed by a community of more than 1,000 individual and institutional investors. Our investor base includes both accredited and non-accredited participants, with investments ranging from \$10,000 to over \$9 million. Patient, long-term capital enables us to support organic farmers while building resilient assets and delivering consistent, non-concessionary returns.

HOW YOUR INVESTMENT WORKS

Iroquois Valley works with those who know the land best: farmers and ranchers committed to stewarding it for the long term. We primarily partner with organic row-crop farmers and conservation ranchers across America's Heartland—operators building profitable businesses while strengthening soil health and resilience.

We believe farmers know what their operations need to succeed. We work exclusively with farmers who come to us seeking capital—through a lease or mortgage—to grow or strengthen their organic operations. We are their long-term partners, providing land security, patient capital, and the financial runway to support the transition to organic systems, regenerate soils, and build durable businesses.



OUR PORTFOLIO

We partner with organic farmers who are deeply rooted in their communities. More than half of our farmers come from third-, fourth-, and fifth-generation farm families, bringing multi-generational experience that strengthens operational performance and long-term stewardship.

We approach diversification with discipline across three dimensions: production type, impact, and geography. While we prioritize Midwest row-crop farmland for its strong market opportunity and potential to scale impact. We maintain a diversified portfolio of farmland assets to broaden opportunity and manage risk across market cycles.

INVESTOR ACCESSIBILITY

Both investment options are available through direct investment or eligible retirement accounts. REIT Equity Shares are open to both accredited and non-accredited investors and can be custodied at several traditional brokerage firms. Rooted in Regeneration Notes are available to accredited investors only.
